Here, angels tell us about life on earth.


"These are your ears," said one angel. "With them you will hear the beautiful sounds of the world, like birds and water and singing."
















When she made it to the front of the line, she saw God.


"Come to me, little one," God said. "Let me have a look at you."














"It's impossible to lose this light," God said.

when they are sweet or forgiving.










"Everyone?" she asked. "What about people who are different from me?"




